Leadership Command College Alumni Association College Scholarship Program

The Leadership Command College Alumni Association (LCCAA) is a professional organization of primarily Texas Peace Officers who have successfully completed the Bill Blackwood Leadership & Command College through Texas A&M University in College Station, Texas Women's University in Denton, and Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas. The majority of these officers serve in a supervisory capacity within their respective law enforcement agencies. The LCCAA provides training opportunities to Texas Peace Officers through LCCAA Regional Directors, as well as hosting an annual training conference with innovative speakers. In keeping with the tradition of supporting quality education, the annual LCCAA College Scholarship Program will award at least two separate scholarships of not less than \$500 each to high school seniors who are also children, or grandchildren, of LCCAA members in good standing.

Selection Criteria

Applicants for this scholarship must meet the following to be considered:

1. Applicants who reside in the United States must meet one of the following requirements:
 - a. Be a legal resident of the United States;
 - b. Have been granted permanent residency;
 - c. Have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies;
 - d.** Have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; **OR**
 - e. Have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services.
2. Applicants must be a high school senior at the time the application is received by the Scholarship review Committee.
3. Are not receiving, or are not anticipating the receipt of, 100% college tuition reimbursement from other sources.
4. Applicants must be planning to enroll in a full time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two or four year-college or university.
5. Applicants must have taken the SAT or ACT and have a final score prior to submission of the application.
6. Submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the deadline date listed under the Deadline Date section. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant.
7. Submit three letters of recommendation.
8. The recipients of this scholarship will be selected by the Scholarship Review Committee, which will consist of at least three representatives from the LCCAA Executive Board.
9. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application and all the supporting documentation in one package, which must be received on or before the deadline as set forth below. The Scholarship Review Committee accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the above instructions.
10. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or disability.



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11. The scholarship award will be based on the Scholarship Review Committee's scores of the overall quality of the application and the scholarship application essay. The higher the average scores, the higher the probability of selection.

Deadline Date:

A complete application and supporting documentation, if any, must be submitted for review between February 1st and April 1st of each calendar year. Applications, including all supporting documentation, must be received on or before April 1st of each year to be considered for award. Applications received after April 1st will not be considered. No exceptions.

Award Date:

The Scholarship Review Committee will determine the recipients of this scholarship by the award date of May 1st, annually. You will be notified via email by this date regarding the status of the scholarship. You will receive a notification email, regardless if you were selected as a recipient or not.

Submission Instructions:

All material must be submitted by mail to the following address and received on or before the deadline date. Electronic applications will not be accepted.

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TERMS, CONDITIONS AND DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

By applying for an LCCAA scholarship and/or accepting the scholarship award, the applicant/recipient agrees to the following terms, conditions, and the distribution of scholarship funds.

1. All application submissions shall become the property of LCCAA regardless if applicant is awarded the scholarship. In addition, you agree to cooperate with the LCCAA in executing a consent and release form if requested.
2. Upon the award of the scholarship and applicant's acceptance, the LCCAA shall have the right to use and republish submitted application and any of its contents to reference and acknowledge applicant's/recipient's name and authorship of the application for any purpose, whatsoever. In addition, applicant/recipient agrees to cooperate with the LCCAA in executing a consent and release form if requested.
3. Scholarship award is a cash credit payable to your college or university, by the LCCAA, in the amount stated by scholarship. No check or other cash monies will be given and/or refunded to student at any time. No exceptions.
4. Applicant/recipient must enroll at an accredited two-year, or four year college or university no later than ninety (90) days following the scholarship award date, or unless otherwise determined by the Scholarship Review Committee.
5. Applicant/recipient must stay in attendance as a full time student for the duration of the semester the scholarship is awarded.
6. Applicant/recipient must maintain the minimum grade point average for the semester the scholarship is awarded.
7. Should recipient withdraw from or otherwise fail to complete a course for which registered and for which the Scholarship or a portion of the Scholarship has been used to pay, any refund due shall be only applied to the LCCAA.
8. If recipient wishes to re-take a course, recipient must pay the entire cost of the course. No scholarship award will be given on a re-taken course. A "re-take" of a course means scholarship recipient has completed the course to a point of earning a letter grade of A-F and has been scheduled to repeat the same course.
9. Recipient will relinquish all unused scholarship credits should recipient fail to meet the above terms and conditions for any reason. Determinations of failure to meet the stated terms will be made by the Scholarship Review Committee. Any unused portion of the Scholarship will be returned to the LCCAA.
10. These terms and conditions are in addition to any other terms and conditions set forth in any other part of this document. Any necessary determination or clarification as to the interpretation or to the application of a particular term shall be made by the Scholarship Review Committee in its sole discretion. Furthermore, the LCCAA reserves the right in its sole discretion to make any changes or modifications to the scholarship, including but not limited to, the criteria, the selection process, the deadline dates, and the terms and conditions.
11. In the event that any provision of the terms and conditions of this Scholarship shall be held void, voidable, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of the terms and conditions shall remain in full force and effect.
